Code of Conduct for CNC Umpires

As a member of CNC, your behaviour is a direct reflection of Currambine Netball Club. Currambine Netball Club prides itself on having a positive culture of support and friendship, as well as promoting a healthy competitiveness. Our Club consists of volunteers who give up their free time, in order to provide you with a Club at which to play. Please read and acknowledge your acceptance of the following, by ticking and signing:

In addition to Netball Australia's General Code of Behaviour, you must meet the following requirements with regard to your conduct during any activity held by or under the auspices of Netball Australia, Member Organisations or Affiliates in your role as an umpire.

1. Umpire in accordance with the Official Rules of the Game.
2. Treat all players, coaches, match officials and other umpires with respect.
3. Place the safety and welfare of the players above all else. • Ensure the court and its surrounds are compliant with the rules. • Take appropriate action to manage dangerous play.
4. Maintain a high standard of personal behaviour at all times.
5. Be a positive role model through behaviour and personal appearance projecting a favourable image of netball and umpiring at all times.
6. Be courteous, respectful and open to discussion and interaction.
7. Maintain or improve your current performance level and seek continual improvement.
8. Any use of social media such as Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, Snapchat etc regarding fellow Currambine Club members and their families, Coaches, Umpires, CNC officials, JNA officials and other club teams and officials should be done so in a positive manner.
9. If you are rostered on to umpire a game, 24hrs (at the minimum) notice must be given via text to CNC's Umpire Coordinator if you are unable to umpire your game. (No less than an hour in extreme circumstances)
10. IF late to a game, in accordance with JNA's Umpire Policy, fines will be issued, payable by the umpire.
11. Please be respectful that Umpiring is a paid position, so your responsibility is to CNC and their players first and foremost.
12. CNC logo Umpire shirts are compulsory to wear at all games. A shirt may be purchased for \$25.00 or a loan shirt can be provided with a refundable \$20 bond payment. The bond will be refunded once shirt is returned in good condition.
